**JAMES A. JACK'S MEMOIR OF THREE BOYS MISSING
DEBUTS OCTOBER 9, 2006**

**New Book From Former Chicago Detective
Chronicles The Tragic
Murder of Three Boys in 1955**

CHICAGO, May 2, 2006 – The long-awaited memoir of James A. Jack chronicling the Peterson-Schuessler murders in 1955 will be released for publication October 9, 2006. The book titled *Three Boys Missing: The Tragedy That Exposed The Pedophilia Underworld* tells the heart-breaking story of the brutal attack and murder of three boys, Robert Peterson and John and Anton Schuessler, and the investigation that follows. This tragedy shocked the nation and brought further dismay when the perpetrator escaped justice for more than 40 years.

James Jack was the first detective to speak with one of the father's of the missing boys on the night they disappeared and continued to investigate the murders until he retired from the police force in 1968. Over the past 50 years, he has been frequently quoted in and interviewed by television and print media regarding the Peterson-Schuessler murder case.

Five percent of the royalties from the book will be donated to the Chicago Children's Advocacy Center in honor of Robert Peterson and John and Anton Schuessler.

The National Book Tour for *Three Boys Missing* will begin on October 16, 2006, the 51st anniversary of the event. The tour will include Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Cleveland, Dallas, Denver, Detroit, Houston, Los Angeles, Milwaukee, Minneapolis/St. Paul, New York, San Francisco, Seattle, St. Louis, Philadelphia, Portland, and Washington D.C.
